STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

These were mandated by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales (CBCEW) and the Conference of Religious (COR) when both conferences accepted the 'Safeguarding with Confidence' recommendations of the Cumberlege Commission Review (CCR).

- a) To model and promote good governance with respect to safeguarding within the Church
- b) To set the standards for safeguarding arrangements for the Catholic Church in England and Wales.
- c) To oversee the development and updating of national policies and monitor compliance with those national policies and making recommendations for action.
- d) To annually collate and disseminate safeguarding data gathered from dioceses and religious congregations in England and Wales.,
- e) To develop a culture of sensitivity throughout the Church based on listening and responding to both child and adult victims and survivors.
- f) To ensure that what is done in the name of safeguarding children, young people and adults at risk is open and transparent.
- g) To set the strategic work programme of the CSAS in consultation with CBCEW and COR. This will specifically seek to:
 - Develop a "culture of safeguarding"
 - ii) Promote the "One Church Approach"
 - iii) Commission the CSAS to undertake thematic investigations to assist the NCSC to oversee compliance with nationally agreed policies.
- h) To report annually to the CBCEW and COR on the progress of the NCSC and CSAS.



OPERATIONAL OBJECTIVES

These are largely defined within Recommendations 6 to 15 of "Safeguarding with Confidence"-

- 1. To meet quarterly, with the CSAS Director in attendance.
- 2. Minutes on Part 1 accessible to the public via NCSC website to demonstrate openness and transparency.
- 3. To produce a public Annual Report setting out the key actions and data in safeguarding in the Church in England and Wales
- 4. To report annually to CBCEW and COR through the Chair jointly with the CSAS Director
- 5. To promote the development of the Survivors Advisory Panel to provide the NCSC with advice/knowledge/insight and recommendations.
- 6. To commission a Pastoral Support Service helpline with the Church of England in supporting victims and survivors to make contact with the Christian Church in England and Wales. This will be up and running by 2019.
- 7. To recommend to CBCEW and COR policy updates.
- 8. Members will have a link role to liaise with Dioceses and Religious Commissions to promote best practice.
- 9. A communication strategy will set the direction of the NCSC to ensure safeguarding policies and monitoring compliance are improved by improved sharing information; demonstrate the success of the NCSC work; promote examples of good practice.: Identify, disseminate, celebrate good practice within the NCSC
- 10. Use a training 'away day' for NCSC to explore ways of continuous improvement and demonstrate safeguarding best practice by keeping abreast of the significant developments in current research and benefit from training opportunities to development more robust risk assessment plans.
- 11. Oversee the budget profile of the NCSC, SAP and CSAS.
